A fireplace in a New York City restaurant is certainly the extreme exception, not the rule. The brief escapism that comes with dining out definitely applies to a meal accented by a crackling blaze in the background — the presence of a fireplace, preferably when fully ablaze, can make an already-solid restaurant all the more appealing in freezing temperatures.

Many worthwhile fireplace-addled options around the city are of the clubby, steakhouse variety, though there are some notable exceptions, including tapas joints and cocktail bars. As weeks of alternately chilling, damp, and gray weather set in, here are 17 restaurants that boast fireplaces for a toasty meal.
